What is VOLTRAN? Why does VOLTRAN need volunteer drivers?

VOLTRAN is a free driving service in which volunteers provide rides in their own vehicles to medical appointments and to other critical appointments for those who are unable provide their own transportation. VOLTRAN is an opportunity for volunteers to provide an important service and to help individuals in need.

Who can be a volunteer driver? What qualifications and training are required?

A volunteer driver must have a valid driver's license, a good driving record, and an insured vehicle in good operating order. Each individual is subject to a review process including insurance verification, driver's license verification, and motor vehicle record check. VOLTRAN uses the same criteria for acceptable insurance as required by the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (to avoid DMV penalty payments): bodily injury/death of one person \$25,000, bodily injury/death of two or more persons \$50,000, and property damage \$20,000. Each volunteer must complete a required two-hour orientation/training conducted by VOLTRAN.

1. I will attend a two-hour orientation/training session conducted by VOLTRAN at a time and place which I agree to in a telephone conversation or an email exchange initiated by a VOLTRAN coordinator. I will bring my driver's license and my insurance card (or other verification of insurance) to the training session so that workshop leaders may record needed information for VOLTRAN's records.
2. Upon conclusion of the orientation/training, I will volunteer (or decline to volunteer) to become a VOLTRAN driver at least once a month on terms that I specify (frequency with which I am willing to be called, distance that I am willing to drive, and other limits or conditions which I indicate). I may change these terms or discontinue my association with VOLTRAN at any time.
